Extended School Closure: Governor Sisolak extended distance learning for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year. Although the physical meeting for has ended, your education has not. We will continue to conference through Google Meet, build skills using iReady, and take AR tests. Speaking of which, students will now be able to take AR tests until 6:00 p.m..

Student Attendance: We need to know you are okay! You are expected to have some communication with your teacher at LEAST once a week. Your teachers reach out through a variety of efforts: phone, text, email, Google Classroom or Meet, as well as DoJo with your parents. For state attendance purposes, you are expected to respond.

Technology Deployment: Our school is still deploying Chromebooks for student use to complete learning enrichment activities. If you need a device to borrow and have not been contacted by the school, please email Ms. Peffer at peffebd@nv.ccsd.net.

What about my stuff??: We recognize that you may have school books or equipment to return not to mention those Pokémon cards in your desk that you would like. We are unsure of our return plans at this time. The district has a team of people working on contingency plans if the Governor Sisolak feels the need to extend our closure. Know that your stuff is safe and we will share information as soon as it becomes available.

Registration: Online registration is now open. This annual **review** is necessary to review contact information as well as confirm network and media preferences for the 2020 – 2021 school year. Families with students currently enrolled in CCSD can complete registration using the Infinite Campus Parent Portal at campusportal.ccsd.net. The process takes less than five minutes for existing families. Verification is needed even if all of your information remains the same. Families prompted to provide address verification documents will have to wait until school offices are open to share the necessary documentation. REMINDERS: **Acceptable Use Policy AUP** – if you check “no” in this section your child CANNOT have access to technology at school. You must select **YES** to allow access to technology. **Media Release** - If you select “no” in this section, your child cannot be published in the yearbook or newsletter.
