What is it?



When are the courses held?

Courses are held at a variety of times during the week. Contact a Title I Family Engagement Center for specific dates and times.

How do I register?

Families can register for classes at the Title I Family Engagement Center.

How much do the courses cost?

All CCSD University of Family Learning courses are free of charge.

How many classes can I take?

There is no limit to how many courses a person can take.

Are courses for credit?

Academic credits are not offered for University of Family Learning courses. However, we will acknowledge participation and achievement. Upon completion of each course, every participating adult will receive a Certificate of Course Completion. Participants completing 50 hours from January-April 30th, will be recognized at an Achievement Ceremony and receive a Certificate of Success.

Is childcare available?

Yes! When registering, please mark the appropriate box on the registration form. The Title I Family Engagement Centers adhere to the policies and procedures outlined in the CCSD Health Regulations.

Children with temperatures of 100 degrees or higher or who are suffering from vomiting or diarrhea should stay home from school. Children may return to school after being free from vomiting, fever and diarrhea for a period of 24 hours.

In addition, any CCSD student who did not attend school due to illness, appointments, or disciplinary issues is not permitted to attend the family center.






My Family and Me Tiny Tots


